

Optimus Meal Delivery Cart

Independent Sanitation Certification | Proof of Compliance

WHAT ETL SANITATION CERTIFICATION MEANS

Third-party sanitation certification independently verifies that equipment meets the standards health inspectors, surveyors, and purchasing departments rely on. The Optimus cart carries the ETL Sanitation Listed mark, issued by Intertek, an ANSI-accredited certification body. This means the cart has been tested and certified to NSF/ANSI sanitation standards – the same standards referenced by health departments, The Joint Commission, and CMS surveyors nationwide. The certification is publicly verifiable, and the manufacturing facility is subject to annual re-inspection.

Not all meal delivery carts on the market carry third-party sanitation certification. Statements such as “built to sanitary standards” or “food-safe design” do not indicate third-party certification. If a cart doesn’t carry the mark, the facility assumes the compliance risk.

WHAT THE CERTIFICATION COVERS

CLEANABILITY	TEMPERATURE PERFORMANCE	MATERIAL SAFETY
Equipment design and construction verified to prevent buildup of contaminants. Joints, seams, fasteners, and surface finishes independently evaluated. Clean-in-place processes lab-tested for bacterial reduction.	Hot and cold holding temperatures tested and verified to meet food safety thresholds. Equipment must maintain required temperatures under real-world operating conditions to prevent bacterial growth.	All food-contact surfaces tested for compliance with FDA regulations (21 CFR). Materials verified to prevent harmful chemical leaching. Lead content compliance confirmed per NSF/ANSI 372.

VERIFY THE CERTIFICATION YOURSELF

The Optimus cart’s ETL Sanitation certification is publicly listed and can be verified by any buyer, purchasing department, or compliance officer. Ask any competing manufacturer to provide the same verification for their equipment.

A NOTE FOR PURCHASING & COMPLIANCE TEAMS

When evaluating meal delivery equipment, confirm that any cart under consideration carries a current, independently issued sanitation certification mark — not just a manufacturer’s claim of compliance. Look for the mark shown here. Request certification documentation from all vendors under consideration.
